- 4. Your submission may include additional information or documentation you feel will enhance your application.
- 5. To be considered, your application for the 2022-2023 academic year must be received by **11:59 pm on August 31, 2022**.
- 6. At its discretion the Bursary Committee may request an interview.
- 7. The selected applicant will be announced and the bursary award presented on a date and time to be determined and co-ordinated with the winner and a member of the CCA Committee subject to the recipient's confirmation of enrolment.
